

For the March BOM, you will make four small paper pieced blocks (referred to as Corner Blocks) that will connect to form one total block (referred to as Whole Block). You will need to adjust the fabric piece sizes if you plan on fussing cutting. Four copies of the Corner Blocks are included in this .pdf, so be sure to print one copy of the .pdf.

These fabric suggestions are for the one whole block; however, you are welcome to use any combination of scraps you have.

Fabric requirements for the Whole Block:

Color 1 fabric: 17" x 8"

Color 2 fabric: 17" x 20" or approximately 1 fat quarter

Color 3 fabric: 17" x 20" or approximately 1 fat quarter

From the above fabric suggestions, you will cut as instructed below for each Corner Block. Please note, the individual fabric pieces required to sew the corner blocks are labeled on each of the paper pieces to make it easier to construct.
